TO PROMOTE RESPONSIBILITY FOR OWN LEARNING

Process-Focused Criteria

Materials

- Process focused criteria posted where it can be seen by all students
- Or individual copies for each student

Learning targets are product focused. When a teacher states the learning target, he is letting his students know what they are supposed to be able to do after instruction. Alternately, process-focused criteria inform students how to successfully reach the target.

As a formative assessment technique, processfocused criteria let a student know if she is headed in the right direction.



Procedure

Examine the synthesis of component skills needed to reach the learning target.
Separate these skills and list them as a process for success.

Example of Process-Focused Criteria

Learning intention: to show how energy *transfers* from one place to another in a given system.

Process success criteria: the representation includes the following:

- a diagram of the system
- labeled forms of energy
- labeled energy transfers
- arrows that show energy transfer from one place to another
