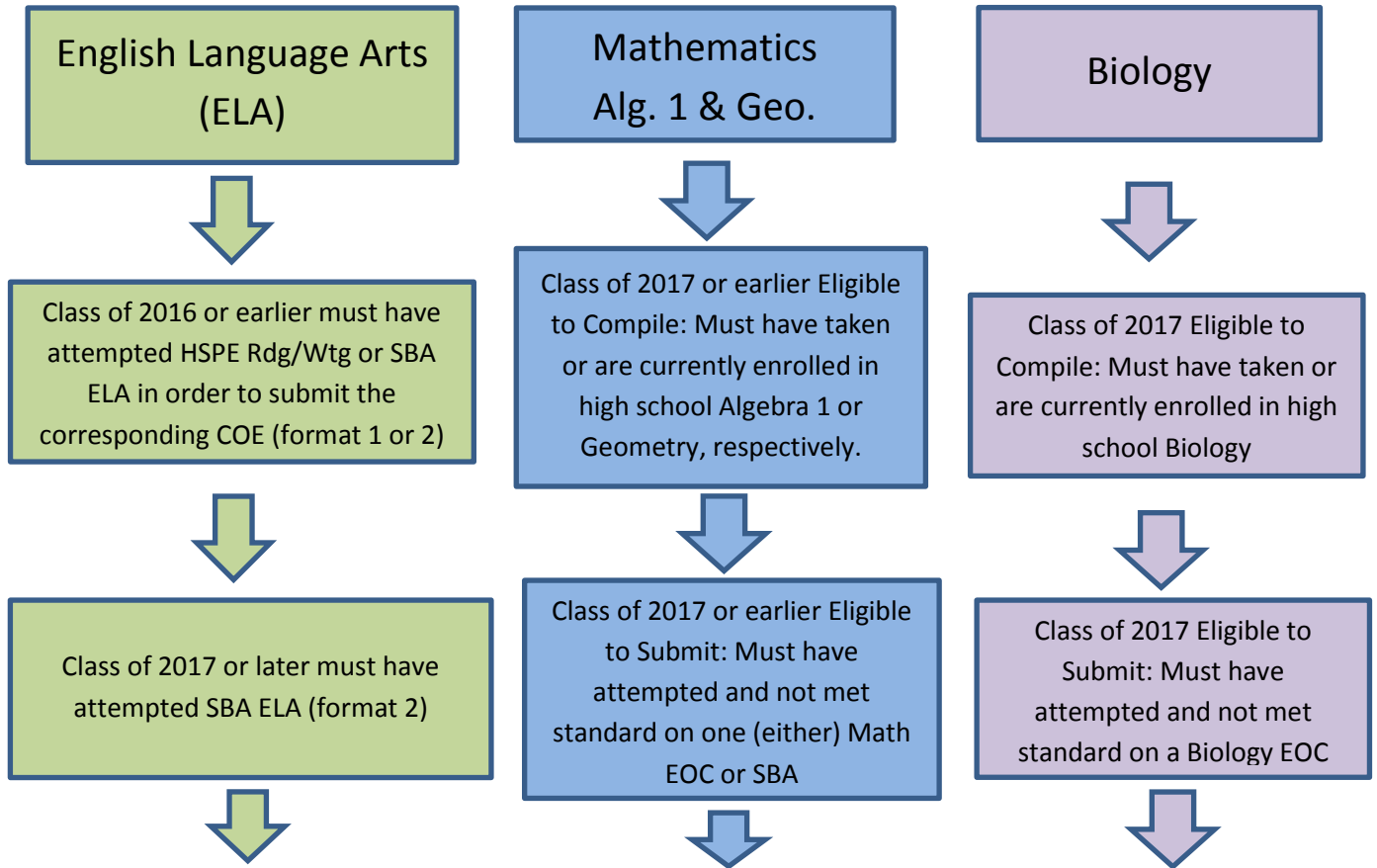


# Collection of Evidence Eligibility Flowchart in 2015-16



Students can submit more than one collection per content area, districts will receive only one stipend.  
A COE must meet all sufficiency requirements in order to be scored.

**Format 2 ELA**

- 6 tasks required, each using 3 Claims:
- Two segments to each task
  - Segment 1 available in September 2015
    - Claim 1 short responses & Claim 2 Brief Writes
  - Segment 2 available in October 2015
    - Classroom Activity
    - Claim 4 Research & Claim 2 Full Writes

**Format 2 Math & Biology**

- 4 tasks, 1 is on demand  
(On-demand task cannot contain Claim 4 targets)
- Each task has 5 questions
- Part online, part paper/pencil

***Students who do not meet standard may submit a complete collection in the next submission cycle.***
