

## Locally-Administered Assessment (COE Local) Training Opportunities

OSPI will be convening a series of in-person training events, focused on the activity of scoring the COE Local ELA and math tasks that districts may be using as part of the Locally-Determined Course/Locally-Administered Assessment graduation alternative.

The intended audience for these trainings is teachers or other staff who will be directly involved in the scoring of student work. Space will be limited to 40 attendees with an expectation of even representation of English language arts (ELA) and math educators. Due to the space considerations, it is recommended that districts send no more than 4 educators.

Acknowledging that interest in these events may be larger than space will allow, OSPI will also post to the Moodle sites (ELA and math) a recorded version of the training.
