Tableau Server

- Data Posted out to the Tableau Server has two purposes –
 - Analysis
 - Validation of public reporting
- Two ways to navigate –
 - Log into EDS and find 'Tableau Server' application
 - Navigate directly to <https://tableau.ospi.k12.wa.us>
 - If Tableau Server doesn't show on your application list, contact your district data manager and request access. For student level data, you'll need the Tableau_SecureDataPortal_Student_Interactor role

Public Reporting

- Data Portal
 - Repository of all data housed on the K-12 Site
- Report Card
 - Parent focused tool to report out high level data summaries



Data Portal

- Some datasets are downloaded directly from the portal
- Larger, more complex data will redirect user to data.wa.gov, Washington State's open data portal
 - This site will contain additional information about the data
 - Give users the ability to create custom downloads



Report Card

- <https://washingtonstatereportcard.ospi.k12.wa.us>
- Redesigned in December 2018
- Parent focused tool to provide summary level information over a wide range of topics
- Frequent updates
 - Since December, we've had 7 additional releases with either new data or new functionality
