Improving consistency and alignment in the implementation of PBIS and restorative strategies increases student access to quality instructional time and school success. ## Tier 1 PBIS Leadership Team Training

(Team of 5 or more Required for Registration)

In Tier 1 PBIS, a representative school team builds the foundation for PBIS by focusing on evidenced based school-wide prevention and intervention practices. Schools will often see an improvement in the behavior of 80 percent of students as they implement Tier 1 PBIS!

Across the 2 days, we will cover:

- PBIS Tier 1 Leadership Teams
- setting & teaching expected behavior
- Building relationship & feedback for desired behaviors
- Behavioral response systems
- Using data for decision making

Participants will learn to :

- Build a multi-tiered system of supports beginning with Tier 1
- Establish effective prevention and intervention strategies
- Find and use evidenced based practices and strategies
- Monitor progress and use data for decision making
- Create a year-long action plan for implementation

## Strategies to Improve Schoolwide/Classroom Climates & Support Success for All Learners

This is an interactive workshop designed for teachers, instructional/behavioral coaches, administrators and PBIS facilitators who want to explore tools, strategies and mindsets that can be used to build a positive, strength-based school/classroom climate that is based on evidence based practices and grounded in compassion, achievement and hope.

Across the 2 days, we will cover:

- The 3 foundational facets critical to building a high-achieving culture for ALL students: compassion, achievement and hope.
- How these facets come to life on a daily basis through consistent implementation of key PBIS classroom management strategies.
- Strategies & resources for supporting the development and implementation of these practices in their schools and classrooms.

Participants will:

- Explore beliefs, life experiences, personal context and the impact they have on our classroom & school climate/culture.
- Understand ways to increase positive relationships with staff, students and families.
- Practice strategies & frameworks for effective coaching on classroom PBIS strategies.
- Apply restorative & research based PBIS practices to support effective classroom management & build a positive climate.
