

Leadership for Deeper Learning

AT ESD 189, we have launched an Associate Cluster for Deep Learning which is a group of schools that are embarking on learning about new pedagogies to create deep learning in every classroom for every student. Districts and their selected schools will be working collaboratively with other districts in our region over the next few years to learn how to change their systems to support new teaching strategies for 21st Century learning. New Pedagogies for Deep Learning (NPDL) is offering district leadership team training for districts/schools that would want to be part of this collaborative learning. Session I: September 22-23 at ESD 189, Anacortes (The Learner First Change Team Training)

Overview: High Level Overview of the "why" and the "big ideas" on Deeper Learning, including implementation of The Iceberg, 5 Assumption Shatterers, Theory of Change, Authentic Mixed Method Assessment (AMMA), The Inquiry Cycle, and the Change Process.

Outcomes for districts and school teams:

High Functioning Teams: Learn how to create high functioning teams that will lead change at the school and district level.

Setting the Stage for Success: Learn Communication and involvement strategies for staff and school community.

Culture, Culture Change and the Iceberg: Gain clarity on the concept of culture and how to make deep systemic changes.

Role of the Change Catalyst: Learn the role of the Change Catalysts and the needed skills.

Deep Dive into the Tools: Learn how to use the many tools from NPDL, such as the rubrics for system conditions, Lesson Design, Learning Progressions, and The Hub.

Annual Cycle and Timeline: Learn how the pieces fit together over the course of a school year, and create a plan for change.
