## **Summer Writing Institute**

July 29-August 1 @ NWESD

**Facilitated by the Puget Sound Writing Consortium**

*Creating communities of writers in Washington's schools*

Teachers who write are the best teachers of writing. This four-day institute focuses on teachers developing their own writing craft while learning strategies to support student writers in the classroom. Led by former facilitators of the Writing Project at the University of Washington, this highly engaging and interactive writing workshop is designed to empower teachers to view themselves as teacher-writers. Participants will leave the institute with a multitude of writing skills and tools to implement with their students. *Lunch included.*
