Mission



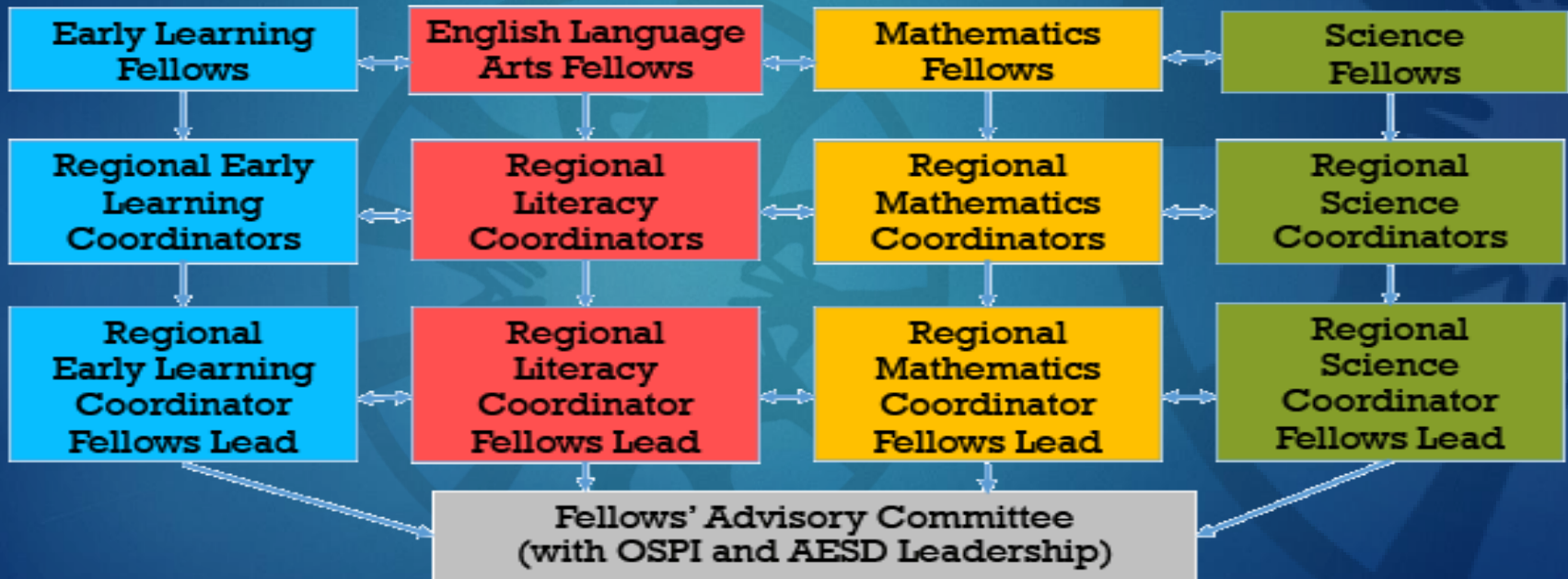

The Work of the Fellows will result in measurable growth for every student in every learning environment in Washington.

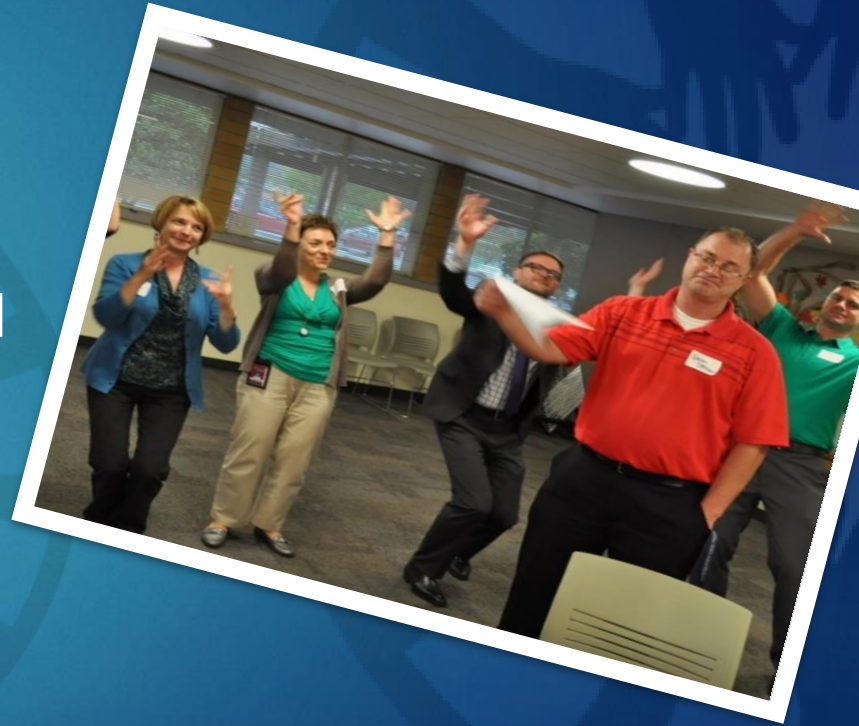


The Fellows Structure

- ▶ Emeritus after 3 years

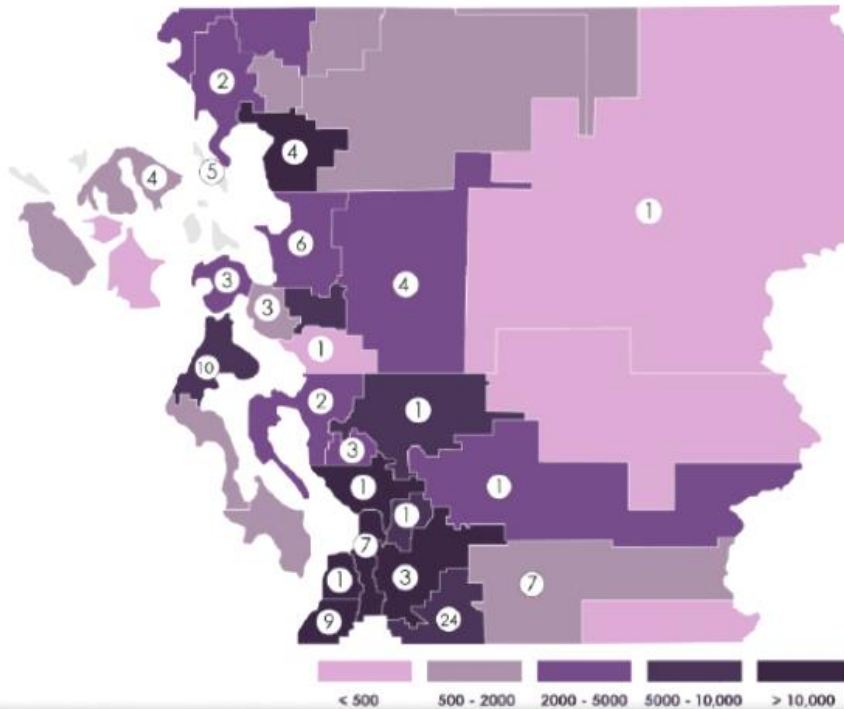
Emeritus Fellows
