English Language Learners Add-on Endorsement Program Overview NWESD 189

Thank you for your interest in SPU's ELL Endorsement program. Please review the timeline below:

- 1) All candidates must apply to the SPU endorsement program.**
 - a. Candidate must hold a current WA State Teaching Certificate to apply.
 - b. At time of application, make sure to specify your affiliation with NWESD 189 to be eligible for discounted tuition prices.
 - c. Application fee is \$200.00 and is non-refundable.
 - d. If you have taken prior coursework that might substitute toward the program of study, submit a CSSA to request a transcript review at time of program application.

- 2) Complete all required coursework (outlined on plan of study.)**
 - a. As the endorsement programs are open-ended, each candidate is responsible for keeping track of deadlines and enrolling in necessary courses.
 - b. Each candidate is provided five years from admission to complete coursework.
 - c. Candidates are required to have an official transcripts sent to SPU upon completion of any work done outside of SPU.

- 3) Pass all appropriate testing- WEST-# #051**
 - a. Choose SPU as an electronic recipient during your test sessions.

- 4) Complete EDCN 5730: Field Experience Pedagogy Assessment**

After completing steps 1-3, the candidate is eligible for placement in EDCN 5730. Express intent by contacting endorse@spu.edu. Cohorts tend to fill quickly. To avoid being waitlisted, consult the chart below.

October 31 st	Winter Quarter (January-March)
January 31 st	Spring Quarter (March-June)

NOTE: Application to the endorsement program must occur 90 days prior to requesting placement in EDCN 5730 Field Experience. Otherwise, you will be subject to a **\$75.00 expedited processing fee**.
