Hello Colleagues – Based on past communication with your district, this grant announcement may be of some interest.

PREP is a federally funded teen pregnancy prevention project that utilizes evidence-based curricula to reduce risk-taking behavior on the part of secondary school youth.

Grantees receive a curriculum, professional development, technical assistance PLUS a one-time grant of \$10,000 to support implementation and data collection. The deadline for applications is May 15th.
