Five Senses



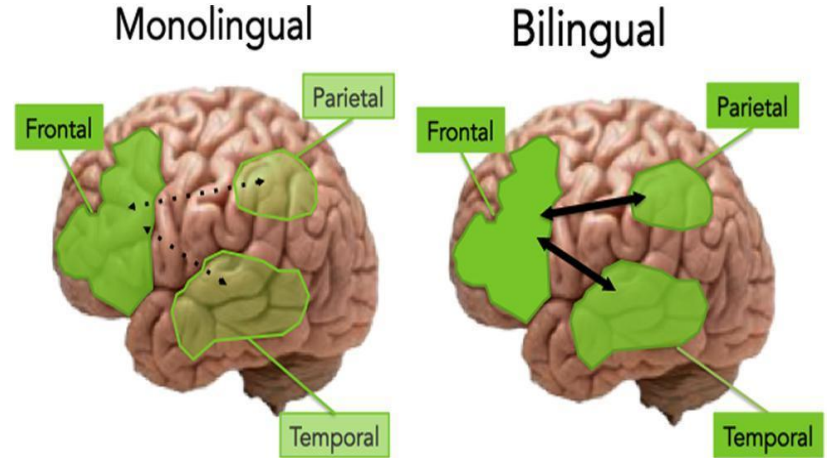
