

LAP is a supplemental services program that assists underachieving students and aims to reduce disruptive behaviors in the classroom. LAP programs serve eligible students who need academic support for English language arts and mathematics, or who need to develop the readiness skills to successfully learn these core content areas. LAP also serves students who need behavioral support in order to reduce disruptive behavior in the classroom. Lastly, five percent of LAP funds may be used for "Readiness to Learn" services, which include the development of partnerships with external organizations to provide academic and non-academic supports for students and their families. These supports are intended to reduce barriers to learning, increase student engagement, and improve readiness to learn.

In accordance with [ESSB 5946: Strengthening Student Educational Outcomes](#), districts are required to report to OSPI the amount of academic growth gained by students participating in the Learning Assistance Program, as well as their entrance and exit assessment information. Districts are also required to report the practices, activities, and programs that were used to support LAP students to demonstrate which are the most effective. This application will be used to collect the all required LAP data.
