For the 18-credit ELL endorsement, required classes include:

TCH_LRN 401/501 (3 credits; Pass/Fail)

ELL Practicum

Work with your students and create a portfolio that meets the standards. Offered in Spring semester.

TCH_LRN 410/510 (3 credits)

Foundations of the Schooling of Language Minority Learners

Study an overview of theory, research, and applications in second language acquisition, language policy, and the development of educational programs for linguistically and culturally diverse students. Offered in Fall semester.

TCH_LRN 409/509 (3 credits)

Curriculum and Assessment for English Language Learners

Learn key concepts related to curriculum development for and assessment of ELLs. Offered in Fall.

TCH_LRN 339/549 (3 credits)

Communicating in Diverse Classrooms

Examine the complex linguistic, social, and cultural issues affecting the achievement of English language learners in classrooms. Offered in Fall semester.

TCH_LRN 414/514 (3 credits)

ELL Materials and Methods

Learn key concepts in methodology, including teaching strategies and techniques to support ELLs across the curriculum. Offered in Spring semester.
