- 5.1 & 5.2: What systems are in place to monitor student achievement progress? To what extent have your School Improvement Plan goals (AMOs, SMART goals) been met to date?
- 8.3: What sources of data are you using to demonstrate student growth?
- o Discuss other principal and evaluator-selected goals, as applicable.

Review of Other District Priorities

- Developing high-performing teacher teams
 - What structures and strategies are you using both to grow teacher leadership and an increased focus on student achievement improvement? To what extent are Learning Improvement days being used optimally for this purpose?
- Transitions (early learning, MS, HS, post-secondary readiness indicators)
 - What structures and strategies are you using to prepare your students for learning-stage transitions? How are you communicating critical readiness factors with parents?
- Promoting a culturally relevant learning environment & school community
 - How are students historically on the social and academic margins faring? How do you know? To what extent have your SIP strategies around equity and access been successful to date?
