

Exploring the 8 Criteria for Leaders in the AWSP Framework

Purpose: To explore the AWSP leadership framework and how each of the 8 criteria are explained in the AWSP document.

Roles: Facilitator, Presenter, Timekeeper, and Recorder

Protocol

Form groups based on color dot on your name tag.

RED: Criteria 1 & 2	BLUE: Criteria 3 & 4	GREEN: Criteria 5 & 7	ORANGE: Criteria 6 & 8
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10 minutes
(Alone)

Review language for each criteria

- Each group select roles
- Each member in the group selects a different element in the criteria. **(excluding 3.5, 5.5, and 8.3)**
- Group members independently review the element for their criteria using the AWSP Leadership Framework and Rubrics. Pay particular attention to the “Examples of Evidence/Measures” and attend to the language in each of the four rating levels for the specific “Element” assigned.

25 minutes
(Team Time)

Group discusses each element by answering the following questions.
Recorder summarizes key points on poster paper:

- What Principals would be doing to be “proficient” under the specific element? What would make them distinguished?
- What observables and collectibles would be the evidence that Principals would collect to be proficient and or distinguished?

20 minutes
(All)

Presenter from each team reports on:

- What Principal would be doing to be proficient/distinguished
- What would be the evidence?
