Context:


There are some miscellaneous settings that must be configured in order for the eVAL tool to display (or not display) various features. The configurations are made by your district's **District Administrator of eVAL**, and may depend on several factors: the instructional framework your district has chosen, your union negotiations, your district's work flow and calendar, etc.

This document simply displays the settings that the **District Administrator of eVAL** must configure in his/her the **Settings** menu. The screen snaps do not reflect your district settings, or any recommended settings.

Please note:

As of November 19, 2016, the District Administrator of eVAL can give the School Administrator and the Principals the right to override the district configurations for the various reports.
